PUBLIC NOTICE NO. 2736

The Mississippi Commission on Wildlife Conservation, at a meeting in Jackson, Mississippi on September 17, 1987, in accordance with Section 25-43-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, made known its intent to adopt and thirty days thereafter did adopt the following regulations relative to reciprocal agreement with the State of Alabama. This was done under authority of Section 49-1-29, Mississippi Code of 1972.

BE IT ORDERED that Public Notice 2399 is hereby repealed and the following reciprocal agreement with Alabama adopted:

That the Mississippi Department of Wildlife Conservation has signed a Reciprocal Agreement with the Alabama Department of Conservation and Natural Resources concerning sport fishing on Aliceville Lake in Noxubee and Lowndes Counties, Mississippi.


Said agreement states that the sport fishing licenses of either Alabama or Mississippi will be recognized in "all that part of the Tombigbee River, its embayment and impoundments, from River Mile 322 to the Aliceville Lock and Dam".


